- Alyssa topic: Softball JBP

- Used new umpires this fall

## O Baseball Report Robbie Nester/Nick Chavis/Michael Roper

- Robbie:
  - Overall smooth
  - o Small issue w/one umpire so that umpire will not return. Chris will remind other umpires standards.
  - One of the players has covid and the manager notified the team. Some of the coaches are allowing kids to shake hands, but need to do hat tip. Mike sent a reminder.

- Alyssa topics:
  - Field rental updates
    - Going into the fall we still owed Rock It \$1,500
    - Looked at softball needs
    - Took all of the remaining spots to give Rock It to use fields until the debt if paid off. If we don't have rain, etc. we should make 2k off fields.
    - \$50 for an hour and half \$70 an hour and half w/lights and they need to provide insurance.
  - Parking at RFP
