- We need to get water turned back on until freezing temps are "over" to clean grill. We need to let vent people know once water back on.

- **Sponsorship Report Amanda Cook**

 - Windscreens are expensive. Some panels that are just getting plain panels when we get more sponsors just have to replace the sponsor wind screen.
 - Notes from January 2019- 5 year limited warranty and cost was more than expected. Windscreens were 2,800. We came out of pocket to pay for win screens.
 - Action:
 - Daniel: need to see how expensive it is to replace "sponsor" windscreen w/plain one w/ability to put small banners on top of that
